2 or 3 liter soda bottles make great – and cheap – containers for water. You can collect rainwater or the condensate from an air conditioner in them,,cap them and leave them out in the sun for half a day to sterilize the water then store them,for years preferably in a dark place to prevent possible algae growth and prevent the plastic of the bottles from becoming brittle). If you can get them, several stores (like Sam’s Club) have a plastic carrier that holds 4 bottles by the neck for easy carrying of 4 bottles at a time.Using these, most people can easily carry over 8 gallons of water in one trip. Wrapping a wire or cord around the neck of a bottle and tying it creates a very effective weight to hold down tarps or plastic sheets (a full two liter bottle weighs almost 4-1/2 pounds) The cut-off tip of a tow liter bottle makes a very good funnel, while the bottom makes a light weightcontainer for all sorts of things




